# From the Pastor of St. Patrick's Parish June 29, 2025



This weekend the church celebrates the feast day of Saints. Peter and Paul. These two saints are so important that their feast day takes precedence even over Sunday. As I reflect on my last week

here in Walla Walla, these two great Apostles are a reminder to me what it means to follow Jesus Christ. For all of us, to be a disciple means we must be ready and willing to go wherever the Lord sends us.

For example, there is the famous story of St. Peter. As Christians in Rome were facing persecutions from the emperor Nero, Peter was leaving the city and had a vision of Jesus passing him in the opposite direction. Peter asked Jesus, "Where are you going, Lord?" ("Quo vadis, Domine?") Jesus replied, "I am going to Rome to be crucified," and then disappeared. Peter realized that Jesus was calling him to go back to Rome to be martyred. He was crucified upside down and was buried underneath the place where St. Peter's Basilica now stands.

St. Paul for his part, perhaps more than any of the original Apostles, was extremely zealous to go to the ends of the earth to bring the gospel. Following every impulse of the Holy Spirit, he traveled through city after city, preaching Jesus Christ, and ending his journey in Rome, where he was beheaded for his faith. Both of these great apostles remind us that this world is not our home, that we are to live in this world as though we are just passing through. Wherever the Lord sends us, may we always be docile and obedient, for the glory of God in the salvation of souls.

"Peter makes his great confession of faith: "You are the Messiah" (Mark 8:29). It was one of the many glorious moments in Peter's life, beginning with the day he was called from his nets along the Sea of Galilee to become a fisher of men for Jesus. The New Testament clearly shows Peter as the leader of the apostles, chosen by Jesus to have a special relationship with him. With James and John he was privileged to witness the Transfiguration, the raising of a dead child to life, and the agony in Gethsemane. His mother-in-law was cured by Jesus. He was sent with John to prepare for the last Passover before Jesus' death. His name is first on every list of apostles. And to Peter only did Jesus say, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matthew 16:17b-19).But the Gospels prove their own trustworthiness by the unflattering details they include about Peter. He clearly had no public relations person. It is a great comfort for ordinary mortals to know that Peter also has his human weakness, even in the presence of Jesus. He generously gave up all things, yet he can ask in childish self-regard, "What are we going to get for all this?" (see Matthew 19:27). He receives the full force of Christ's anger when he objects to the idea of a suffering Messiah: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do" (Matthew 16:23b). Peter is willing to accept Jesus' doctrine of forgiveness, but suggests a limit of seven times. He walks on the water in faith, but sinks in doubt. He refuses to let Jesus wash his feet, then wants his whole body cleansed. He swears at the Last Supper that he will never deny Jesus, and then swears to a servant maid that he has never known the man. He loyally resists the first attempt to arrest Jesus by cutting off Malchus' ear, but in the end he runs away with the others. In the depth of his sorrow, Jesus looks on him and forgives him, and he goes out and sheds bitter tears. The Risen Jesus told Peter to feed his lambs and his sheep (John 21:15-17)."

"Paul had been the most pharisaic of Pharisees, the most legalistic of Mosaic lawyers. Now he suddenly appears to other Jews as a heretical welcomer of Gentiles, a traitor and apostate. Paul's central conviction was simple and absolute: Only God can save humanity. No human effort—even the most scrupulous observance of law—can create a human good which we can bring to God as reparation for sin and payment for grace. To be saved from itself, from sin, from the devil, and from death, humanity must open itself completely to the saving power of Jesus. Paul never lost his love for his Jewish family, though he carried on a lifelong debate with them about the uselessness of the Law without Christ. He reminded the Gentiles that they were grafted on the parent stock of the Jews, who were still God's chosen people, the children of the promise."





#### Saint Oliver Plunkett

"The name of today's saint is especially familiar to the Irish and the English—and with good reason. The English martyred Oliver Plunkett for defending the faith in his native Ireland during a period of severe persecution.

Born in County Meath in 1629, Oliver studied for the priesthood in

Rome and was ordained there in 1654. After some years of teaching and service to the poor of Rome he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in Ireland. Four years later, in 1673, a new wave of anti-Catholic persecution began, forcing Archbishop Plunkett to do his pastoral work in secrecy and disguise and to live in hiding. Meanwhile, many of his priests were sent into exile, schools were closed, Church services had to be held in secret, and convents and seminaries were suppressed. As archbishop, Plunkett was viewed as ultimately responsible for any rebellion or political activity among his parishioners. Archbishop Plunkett was arrested and imprisoned in Dublin Castle in 1679, but his trial was moved to London. After deliberating for 15 minutes, a jury found him guilty of fomenting revolt. He was hanged, drawn, and quartered in July 1681. Pope Paul VI canonized Oliver Plunkett in 1975." franciscanmedia.org

# CARTA DEL PÁRROCO 29 de Junio, 2025



Este fin de semana, la Iglesia celebra la solemnidad de los santos Pedro y Pablo. Estos dos santos son tan importantes que su fiesta tiene precedencia incluso sobre el domingo. Al reflexionar sobre mi última

semana aquí en Walla Walla, estos dos grandes apóstoles me recuerdan lo que significa seguir a Jesucristo. Para todos nosotros, ser discípulos significa estar dispuestos y preparados para ir a dondequiera el Señor nos envíe.

Por ejemplo, está la famosa historia de San Pedro. Cuando los cristianos en Roma estaban siendo perseguidos por el emperador Nerón, Pedro estaba saliendo de la ciudad y tuvo una visión de Jesús pasando en dirección contraria. Pedro le preguntó a Jesús: "¿A dónde vas, Señor?" ("Quo vadis, Domine?"). Jesús le respondió: "Voy a Roma a ser crucificado", y luego desapareció. Pedro comprendió que Jesús lo estaba llamando a regresar a Roma para ser martirizado. Fue crucificado cabeza abajo y enterrado en el lugar donde ahora se encuentra la Basílica de San Pedro.

San Pablo, por su parte, quizás más que cualquiera de los apóstoles originales, tuvo un gran celo por llevar el evangelio hasta los confines de la tierra. Siguiendo cada impulso del Espíritu Santo, viajó de ciudad en ciudad predicando a Jesucristo, y terminó su camino en Roma, donde fue decapitado por su fe.

Ambos grandes apóstoles nos recuerdan que este mundo no es nuestro hogar, que debemos vivir en este mundo como si estuviéramos de paso.

Dondequiera que el Señor nos envíe, que seamos siempre dóciles y obedientes, para la gloria de Dios y la salvación de las almas.


"Pedro hace su gran confesión de fe: "Tú eres el Mesías" (Marcos 8,29). Fue uno de los muchos momentos gloriosos en la vida de Pedro, comenzando desde el día en que fue llamado desde sus redes a orillas del mar de Galilea para convertirse en pescador de hombres para Jesús. El Nuevo Testamento muestra claramente a Pedro como el líder de los apóstoles, elegido por Jesús para tener una relación especial con Él. Junto con Santiago y Juan, tuvo el privilegio de presenciar la Transfiguración, la resurrección de una niña y la agonía en Getsemaní. La suegra de Pedro fue curada por Jesús. Fue enviado con Juan a preparar la última Pascua antes de la muerte de Jesús. Su nombre aparece primero en todas las listas de apóstoles. Y solo a Pedro le dijo Jesús: "Dichoso tú, Simón, hijo de Jonás, porque eso no te lo ha revelado ningún hombre, sino mi Padre que está en el cielo. Y yo te digo: Tú eres Pedro, y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia, y el poder del infierno no la derrotará. Te daré las llaves del Reino de los Cielos: lo que ates en la tierra, quedará atado en el cielo, y lo que desates en la tierra, quedará desatado en el cielo" (Mateo 16,17b-19). Pero los Evangelios prueban su propia veracidad por los detalles poco halagadores que incluyen sobre Pedro. Claramente, no tenía un agente de relaciones públicas. Es un gran consuelo para los mortales comunes saber que Pedro también tenía debilidades humanas, incluso en presencia de Jesús. Generosamente lo dejó todo, y sin embargo puede preguntar con egoísmo infantil: "¿Qué vamos a recibir por todo esto?" (ver Mateo 19,27). Recibe la plena fuerza del enojo de Cristo cuando se opone a la idea de un Mesías sufriente: "¡Apártate de mí, Satanás! Eres para mí un obstáculo. Tú piensas como los hombres, no como Dios" (Mateo 16,23b). Pedro está dispuesto a aceptar la doctrina de Jesús sobre el perdón, pero sugiere un límite de siete veces. Camina sobre el agua con fe, pero se hunde por la duda. Se niega a que Jesús le lave los pies, y luego quiere que le lave todo el cuerpo. Jura durante la Última Cena que nunca negará a Jesús, y luego jura a una sirvienta que nunca ha conocido a ese hombre. Lealmente resiste el primer intento de arrestar a Jesús cortándole la oreja a Malco, pero al final huye con los demás. En lo más profundo de su tristeza, Jesús lo mira y lo perdona, y él sale a llorar amargamente. El Jesús resucitado le dijo a Pedro que apacentara sus corderos y sus ovejas (Juan 21,15-17)."

"Pablo había sido el más fariseo de los fariseos, el más legalista de los intérpretes de la ley mosaica. Ahora aparece de repente ante otros judíos como un herético acogedor de gentiles, un traidor y apóstata. La convicción central de Pablo era simple y absoluta: solo Dios puede salvar a la humanidad. Ningún esfuerzo humano —ni siquiera la observancia más escrupulosa de la ley— puede crear un bien humano que podamos presentar a Dios como reparación por el pecado y pago por la gracia. Para ser salvada de sí misma, del pecado, del diablo y de la muerte, la humanidad debe abrirse completamente al poder salvador de Jesús.

Pablo nunca perdió su amor por su familia judía, aunque sostuvo un debate de por vida con ellos sobre la inutilidad de la Ley sin Cristo. Les recordó a los gentiles que habían sido injertados en la raíz del pueblo judío, que seguía siendo el pueblo elegido de Dios, los hijos de la promesa."


