#### From the Pastor of Assumption Parish April 7, 2024



With the end of the pandemic, several parishioners have approached me (and other priests in Walla Walla) to ask when we would return to the use of the chalice in the distribution of Holy Communion. While I do

not presume to speak for the other pastors, I have let my parishioners know that I will not be regularly using the chalice for the distribution of Holy Communion. I will give the three reasons for my decision.

Before proceeding to the reasons, I would like to contextualize this topic. Often, when a pastor makes a change (or chooses to stick with the new status quo), parishioners inquire about the rationale for such a decision. This is understandable. The presumption behind such a query is that, if the reasoning is sufficiently robust, the opinion of both pastor and parishioner theological decisions, practical limitations, will be aligned regarding the decision. Although this can certainly be the case, we often forget that community at every Mass. another motivation underlies nearly all such requests and decisions—personal preference.

When we recognize the power of personal preference, we should keep in mind the axiom de gustibus non est disputandum (in matters of taste, argument is fruitless). In reality, when we are perfectly honest with ourselves, if something is a matter of personal preference, there is a distinct possibility that no reason or explanation will sway us however theologically, philosophically, legally, or practically compelling it may be.

This is true regarding not only the use of the chalice for the distribution of communion, but also for the type of music we sing, church architecture, or our favorite liturgical color. And that's ok! It's perfectly fine to acknowledge we like or dislike certain things regardless of how compelling a case may be for or against them,

whether in the liturgy or in life.

This is just as true for pastors as it is for parishioners. If a pastor says that all his liturgical choices are determined by the options with the most robust theological backing, he is either disingenuous or lacking in self-knowledge.

The Church gives a priest many options in the celebration of the Mass. Yes, sometimes he will make his decisions based on which options are rooted in a deeper tradition or a more theologically robust expression of the faith. However, sometimes he will simply choose an option that corresponds to his preference. At other times, he will choose options that conform more closely to the preferences of his congregation. In fact, unless you have asked your average parish priest what his preferences are, you may be unaware of how often he sets aside his preferences for the sake of his congregation. Most priests, most of the time, attempt to balance personal preferences, and the preferences of the

Now that I have provided a context for my topic, in the subsequent bulletin letter, I will discuss the regular utilization of the chalice for the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass from theological, legal, practical, and personal perspectives.



#### CARTA DEL PASTOR

7 DE ABRIL DEL 2024



Con el fin de la pandemia, varios feligreses se acercaron a mí (y a otros sacerdotes en Walla Walla) para preguntarme cuándo volveríamos al uso del cáliz en la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión. Si bien no pretendo hablar en nombre de los otros pastores,

les he hecho saber a mis feligreses que no usaré regularmente el cáliz para la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión. Daré las tres razones de mi decisión.

Antes de pasar a los motivos, me gustaría contextualizar este tema. A menudo, cuando un pastor hace un cambio (o elige seguir con el nuevo status quo), los feligreses preguntan sobre el fundamento de tal decisión. Esto es comprensible. La presunción detrás de tal consulta es que, si el razonamiento es lo suficientemente sólido, la opinión tanto del párroco como del feligrés estará alineada con respecto a la decisión. Aunque ciertamente este puede ser el caso, a menudo olvidamos que otra motivación subyace a casi todas esas solicitudes y decisiones: la preferencia personal.

Cuando reconocemos el poder de la preferencia personal, debemos tener presente el axioma de gustibus non est disputandum (en cuestiones de gusto, la discusión es infructuosa). En realidad, cuando somos perfectamente honestos con nosotros mismos, si algo es una cuestión de preferencia personal, existe una clara posibilidad de que ninguna razón o explicación nos influya por muy convincente que sea teológica, filosófica, legal o prácticamente.

Esto se aplica no sólo al uso del cáliz para la distribución de la comunión, sino también al tipo de música que cantamos, la arquitectura de la iglesia o nuestro color litúrgico favorito. ¡Y eso está bien!

Está perfectamente bien reconocer que nos gustan o no ciertas cosas, independientemente de cuán convincente pueda ser un caso a favor o en contra de ellas, ya sea en la liturgia o en la vida.

Esto es tan cierto para los pastores como para los feligreses. Si un pastor dice que todas sus elecciones litúrgicas están determinadas por las opciones con el respaldo teológico más sólido, es falso o carece de autoconocimiento.

La Iglesia le da al sacerdote muchas opciones en la celebración de la Misa. Sí, a veces tomará sus decisiones basándose en qué opciones están arraigadas en una tradición más profunda o en una expresión de la fe más sólida teológicamente. Sin embargo, a veces simplemente elegirá una opción que corresponda a sus preferencias. En otras ocasiones, elegirá opciones que se ajusten más a las preferencias de su congregación. De hecho, a menos que le haya preguntado al párroco promedio cuáles son sus preferencias, es posible que no se dé cuenta de la frecuencia con la que deja de lado sus preferencias por el bien de su congregación. La mayoría de los sacerdotes, la mayor parte del tiempo, intentan equilibrar las decisiones teológicas, las limitaciones prácticas, las preferencias personales y las preferencias de la comunidad en cada Misa.

Ahora que he proporcionado un contexto para mi tema, en la carta informativa siguiente, discutiré la utilización regular del cáliz para la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión en la Misa desde perspectivas teológicas, legales, prácticas y personales.

¡Alabado sea Jesucristo! ¡Ahora y siempre!
